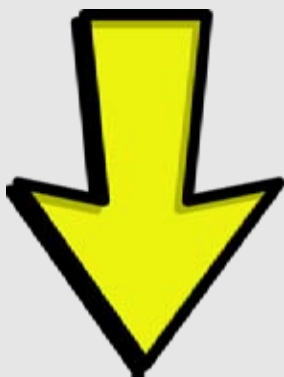
So, you need to order some forks. But those people at Koke are gonna ask questions...they ALWAYS ask questions. **Having the make and model number is NOT enough.**

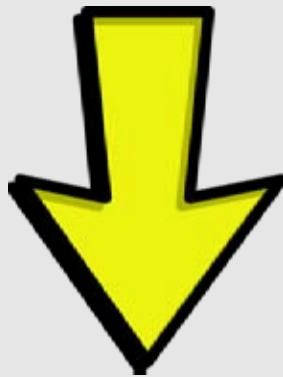

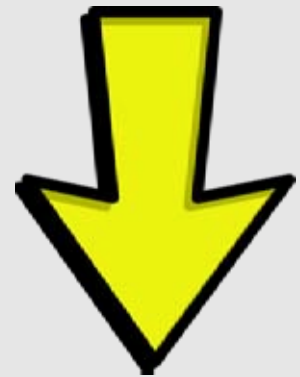

# Hook Type Forks

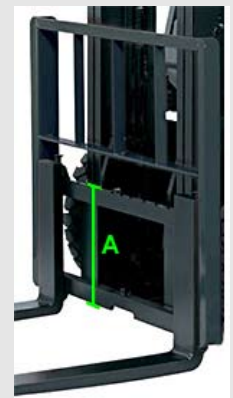
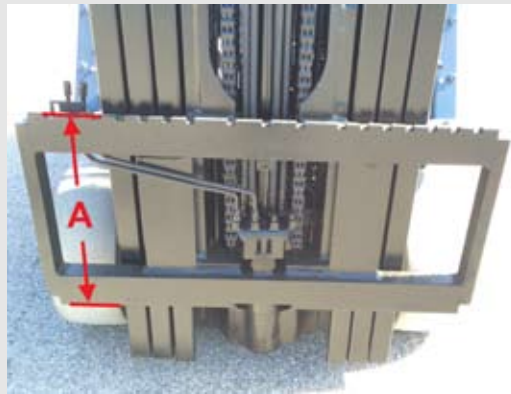


Ordering hook type forks is simple. It comes down to 4 questions:

1. What class is the carriage on the forklift?

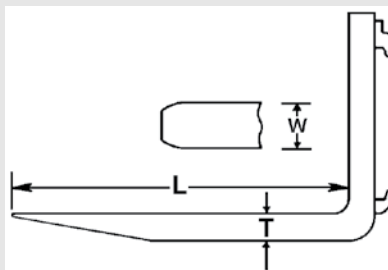
To determine that, all we need is to measure the height of the carriage (from the top of the top carriage bar to the bottom of the bottom carriage bar). Please see the pictures below for reference.

- A=16" - Class 2
- A=20" - Class 3
- A=25" - Class 4



2. What size fork are do you want?

We need to know Width, Length & Thickness as per the drawing below.

3. What taper do you need?





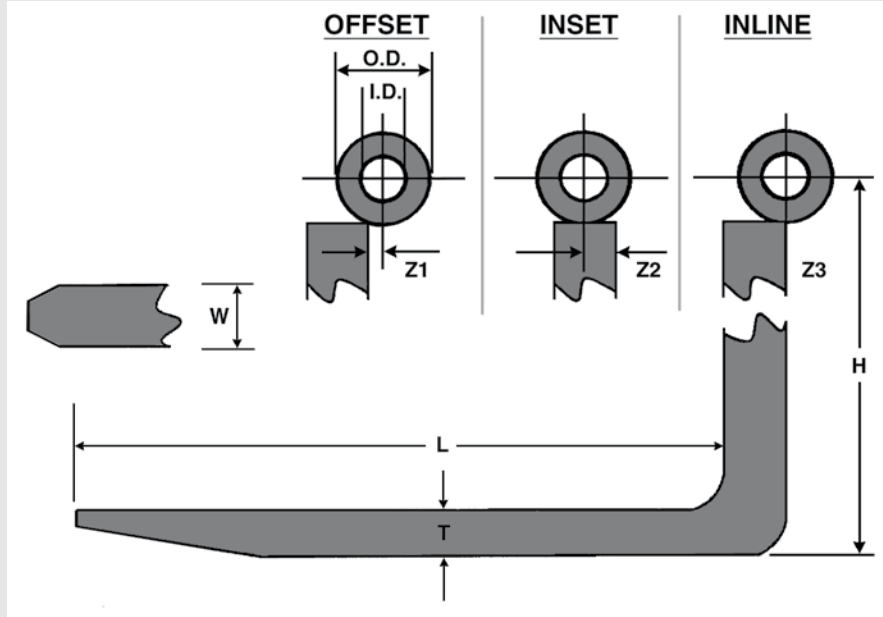
